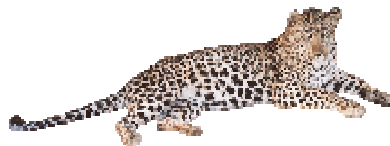
Days 6: After breakfast our journey via Mpumalanga; God's Window, Burke's Luck Potholes and Blyde River Canyon, back to Johannesburg begins. **Guesthouse B&B, D**

Day 7-12: Fly to Maun, Botswana. Visit the Okavango delta; enjoy a picnic under the shade of a sausage tree, Moremi, superb reserve for viewing all animal and bird species, Savuti and Chobe, home to the largest concentration of elephant in Africa, as well as hippo, buffalo, antelope and lion. **Mobile camping B&B, L&D**

Day 13: Travel overland, crossing the border into Zimbabwe for a guided walking tour of Victoria Falls, one of the great natural wonders of the world. Later, board a flight to Cape Town. **Guest House B&B**

Day 14: After breakfast your day is around the Cape Peninsula. We visit a colony of endangered African penguins. We then continue to Cape Point, the most southwestern tip of Africa and Hout Bay for lunch. Weather permitting we end the day on Table Mountain. **Guest House B&B**
