## ***Itinerary Highlights:***

### **Day 1**

Welcome to Cape Town. We meet you at the airport and you are directly transferred to your guesthouse. Settle in at your luxury up market guesthouse, close to the Victoria and Alfred Waterfront, etc. The rest of the day is at leisure – relax, soak up the sun next to the swimming pool; take a walk on the beach. This evening meet your fellow travelers and enjoy a welcome dinner presented by your hosts. ***Guest House B&B, D***

### **Day 2**

After breakfast our first day is around the Cape Peninsula. We drive via False Bay and Simons Town to a colony of endangered African penguins. We then continue to the Cape Peninsula National Park and Cape Point. Within the reserve, a wide range of indigenous fynbos, as well as, baboons, antelope and Cape Mountain Zebra can be seen. Take a photo at the most southwestern tip of Africa and admire the views from the cliff tops at the old Lighthouse. We then continue down into the Constantia Valley. In the afternoon, we head towards Hout Bay for lunch and then continue our peninsula tour via Llandudno to Camp’s Bay - take a walk on the beach or enjoy a cocktail at one of the many beachfront cafe’s. Weather permitting we end the day on Table Mountain. ***Guest House B&B***

### **Day 3-**

This morning we visit V&A Waterfront - the Cape Town harbour with it’s wide selection of boutiques and markets, cafe's and restaurants, shops and entertainment, between the yacht, tug-boats and commercial quays. From here you can also take the ferry to Robben Island and visit the prison that was home to Nelson Mandela or take a 2 hour city tour. As the sun sets over the ocean in a breathtaking display of color, we sit back and relax and reflect on another day crammed with fun, sun and delightful hospitality. ***Guest House B&B***

### **Day 4**

Wine Route - Close to Cape Town you find the wine region, with Stellenbosch as it’s center. The day starts with a morning visit to the heart of this old town, it’s streets lined with old oak trees. We continue to the beautiful town of Franshoek, rich in history; passing the Victor Verster Prison where former President Nelson Mandela was released in 1990. This afternoon we have lunch and discover the main street of Franshoek. A very warm welcome awaits us at our guest house. ***Franshoek Guest House B&B***

### **Day 5**

Today we do a wine tour in this region; visit 3 wine cellars and enjoy lunch on a wine estate. ***Franshoek Guest House B&B, L***

### **Day 6**

Early morning transfer to the airport for our flight to Johannesburg. We start our journey towards Mpumalanga and the world famous Kruger National Park. ***Guest House / Lodge B&B, D***

### **Day 7**

After an early breakfast our day starts with a tour of the stunning Mpumalanga panorama route. Some places of interest we visit include: The Pinnacle - a stack on the edge of the escarpment, Bourke's Luck potholes - fascinating rock forms at the confluence of the Blyde and Treur Rivers, Blyde River Canyon – endless viewpoints over the third largest, only green canyon in the world, some impressive scenery and deep waterfalls, Graskop and if time permits, a cultural tribal village. Late afternoon we return to our lodge/hotel for a relaxing evening.

### **Day 8, 9 & 10**

We enter the world famous Kruger National park, the largest game reserve in South Africa. Two days, 3 nights of game drives and bush walks show us the spectacular variety of wildlife, the Kruger is famous for. (Namely the "Big Five" (elephant, rhino, buffalo, lion and leopard). We explore the bush in an open safari vehicle, both day and night. Our bush walks are accompanied by an expert ranger and it is an opportunity to learn and observe fascinating facts about the African bush. To complete our African safari experience; we enjoy sundowners and relax the evenings around the camp fire. ***Kruger Rest Camp B&B,D***

### **Day 11 to 14 Swaziland**

Last 4 days we Visit a Swazi Orphanage and Care Point close to Mbabane. Details on request.

### **Day 15**

After breakfast our journey back to Johannesburg and the airport begins.

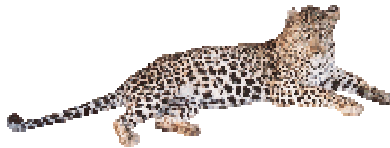
