Itinerary Highlights:

Day 1

Welcome to Cape Town. We meet you at the airport and you are directly transferred to your luxury guesthouse. Settle in. The rest of the day is at leisure. This evening meet your fellow travelers and enjoy a welcome dinner presented by your hosts. ***Guest House B&B, D***

Day 2

After breakfast your first day is around the Cape Peninsula. We drive via False Bay and Simons Town to a colony of endangered African penguins. We then continue to the Cape Peninsula National Park and Cape Point. Take a photo at the most southwestern tip of Africa. We head towards Hout Bay for lunch and then continue our peninsula tour via Llandudno to Camp's Bay. Weather permitting we end the day on Table Mountain.

Day 3-

This morning we visit V&A Waterfront - the Cape Town harbour with its wide selection of boutiques and markets, cafes and restaurants, shops and entertainment. From here you can also take the ferry to Robben Island and visit the prison that was home to Nelson Mandela or take a 2 hour city tour. As the sun sets over the ocean in a breathtaking display of color, we sit back and relax and reflect on another day crammed with fun. ***Guest House B&B***

Day 4

Wine Route - Close to Cape Town lay the wine region, with Stellenbosch as it's center. We continue to the beautiful town of Franshoek, rich in history; passing the Victor Verster Prison where former President Nelson Mandela was released in 1990. This afternoon we have lunch and discover the main street of Franshoek. A very warm welcome await you at your guest house. ***Guest House B&B***

Day 5

Today we do a wine tour in this region; visit 3 wine cellars and enjoy lunch on a wine estate. ***Guest House B&B,L***

Day 6

After breakfast we travel onwards to reach Oudtshoorn, via the scenic route 62 - the heart of the Small Karoo. Lunch on route. We visit an Ostrich farm - touch, feed and ride on an Ostrich! Overnight at a beautiful Lodge. The willow trees and river give a peaceful atmosphere and is food for the soul. If you like nature, this is the place to be!

Day 7

We visit the vast limestone Cango Caves, considered one of the natural wonders of South Africa. We follow the route via Wilderness along the Garden Route to Knysna with its magnificent ocean and mountain views. There is an opportunity to take a lagoon cruise to Featherbed Nature

Reserve. Visit the Knysna Heads, Garden of Eden and Knysna Elephant Park - touch, feel and learn about these ancient animals.

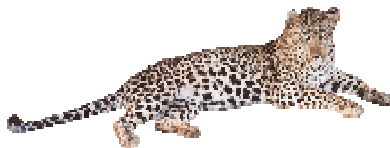
Day 15
